OBJECTIVES

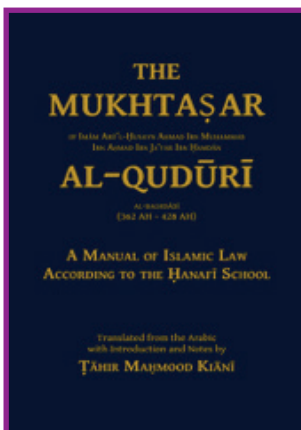
We hope - with the tawfiq of Allah - through this course to:

- Learn/revise important elements of personal fiqh that are fard 'ayn for every Muslim to know
- Learn some elements of communal and societal fiqh that is critical for Muslims to revive
- Appreciate the evidences used and usuli principles adopted by Hanafi fuqaha
- Appreciate the depth of Islamic fiqh and how equally valid differences of opinion arise and how they are measured and compared against each other

METHOD

In trying to balance between the varied priorities of the objectives, we will - inshallah:

- Predominantly go through the ahkam in order to know and understand them correctly
- Highlight the principles that underpin the ahkam and facilitate a stronger grasp of them
- In some cases mention and explain the evidence for the ruling and applied usuli principles
- For one mas'ala each lesson comprehensively present and discuss different opinions across madhahib and their respective reasoning and evidence
- Adopt a discursive, interactive mode of delivery as much as possible
- Select chapters and sections to cover to the exclusion of others



TEXT

We will use as our base text the famous Hanafi primer **Mukhtasar al-Quduri** by Imam Abu al-Hasan Ahmad ibn Muhammad al-Quduri (d. 428 AH).

Students will be given copies of the relevant sections of the English translation by **Sh. Tahir Mahmood Kiani**, which also provides the Arabic text along with the translation.

Instruction and discussion will be based additionally on commentaries on the Mukhtasar, predominately **al-Hidaya** by Imam Burhan al-Deen al-Marghinani (d. 593 AH), as well as compendiums focusing on evidences such as **Athar al-Sunan** by al-Nimawi (d. 1322 AH), **Adillat al-Hanafiya** by al-Bahlawi (d. 1398 AH), and **l'laa' al-Sunan** by al-Thanawi (d. 1394 AH).
